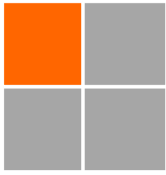

INDUSTRY CHANGES

The timber industry like all industries must go through significant changes to stay in touch with client demands and the demands on our environment. One of the measures being brought into play is the "Chain of Custody". This involves a clear and documented path that the resource (tree) takes from start to finish product, including where, how and why the tree was logged. To obtain certification there are guidelines that must be met, including using a mill which also adheres to the guidelines, not procuring timber that has come from a region that is experiencing civil unrest or has an adverse environment effect. This is a major undertaking and is still in its infancy. Versace is looking to start the journey of becoming certified. This will be an added benefit to all our clients and theirs that our timber is certified and has little or no impact on the environment.
